**- Programme B: All participants participating in the 3 day Programme  
to be on grounds at 8.00am on the Friday 1st December for registration**

- Entrants are required to be a Junior Simmental Member. (Junior Membership form attached, \$11 for the first year. This fee is included in the non-membership entry fee.) If already a junior member, please state prefixes on entry form.

Programme B - (Open to all ages)

- Entry forms are to be returned with payment by the 28th October 2023 if entries have not reached capacity.  
**Positions will only be finalised on receipt of payment.**
- Accommodation for competitors will be available at the Showgrounds. Full catering facilities will be available for the duration of the show.
- The management and control of the Junior Show is in the hands of the organising committee and their decision will be final.
- The Association will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by any participant, and it shall be a condition of entry that each participant shall hold the Society harmless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident.
- The Association will not, under any circumstances, hold itself liable for any accident on the ground or premises.

8. Dress Code - For young Paraders and Judges Competitions - Clean cream jeans or denim, clean long sleeve shirt, tie/scarf/necklace, hat and clean boots. Entrants will be judged on personal presentation throughout the camp.
9. No competitor is permitted to wear a dust coat or sports coat in any competition.
10. Showers, toilets and indoor sleeping areas are available on the ground, however entrants are to supply their own sleeping items/swags and toiletries.
11. Clothes for outside activities.
12. Any entrant under the age of 18 found to be consuming alcohol will be asked leave immediately through their parent's notification and own expense.
13. No participant may leave the grounds without parents approval and prior arrangement made with the organising committee.
14. Any inappropriate behaviour from entrants will not be tolerated and will be dealt with in a manner seen fit by the organising committee.
15. All competitors enter at their own risk. Insurance and public liability is a responsibility of the entrant/owner/exhibitor.
16. Any damages of equipment and/or bibs will be invoiced at the end of the camp for \$25.

**YOU DO NOT REQUIRE YOUR OWN ANIMAL TO ENTER**

### **CATTLE ENTRIES:**

- Led Steer/Heifer can be ANY BREED for the Led Steer/Heifer Show.
- Cows and calves to be entered, calves must be under 9 months old.
- Every animal must have a nose grip or nose ring if over the age of 9 months.
- Bulls over 21 months are not allowed.
- Steers must be milk tooth.
- Steers can be any breed.
- All females and males must be of purebred status registered of the Australian Simmental Society.
- All exhibits must have an acceptable temperament and be broken in to lead. Animals entered in the 9 months and over must have nose rings or nose clips fitted.
- All cattle exhibitors must state their JBAS Status on entry form, all cattle must be a JBAS 6 or above.
- Neck straps are compulsory.
- Exhibitors to supply their own neck straps, halters, show sticks, cattle feed, water buckets, feed dishes and equipment. Bedding will be supplied.
- All cattle must be presented Tick Free.
- NLIS tagging - All animals are required to carry NLIS tags before entry to the Showgrounds. Reading of the tags will be arranged by the committee.

The Association maintains the registered herdbooks of the Simmental, Black Simmental, Red Simmental, SimAngus and Simbrah breeds. Ownership transfers are recorded and members receive registration certificates for all registered progeny.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>COMMERCIAL CATTLE BREEDERS</b></li></ul>	<p>Become a Commercial member and enjoy the wide range of services available. While unable to register cattle or enjoy a voting right, Commercial members may record their herds in Simmental IGS Evaluation.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>TECHNICAL SERVICES</b></li></ul>	<p>Whether a newcomer to the cattle industry or an experienced cattle breeder, you can benefit from the Association's Technical Support and Advisory Service.</p> <p>Genetic performance of animals throughout the breed is regularly evaluated, providing members with invaluable information for their selection and marketing programs.</p>

## The Association provides for the following memberships

- **STUD** Membership is available to any person wishing to register Simmental animals, but you must be over the age of 18 to vote.
- **JUNIOR** Membership is available for those up to 25 years of age. There is no requirement to own cattle, but junior members may operate a stud herd, if desired. Junior members do not have a voting right.
- **COMMERCIAL** Membership enables beef producers interested in the breed to participate and receive the benefits and privileges. Commercial members do not have a voting right, but they are welcome to attend all meetings and functions. Commercial members may not register cattle, but may record their herds in Simmental IGS Evaluation.
- **ASSOCIATE** Membership allows members to remain aware of the progress of the breed by receiving copies of all Simmental publications. Associate members do not have a voting right.

## STUD MEMBERSHIP

Stud members may operate a stud herd, enabling pedigree recording and marketing of registered cattle. To join as a Stud Member, you may own one or more head of cattle registered in the Association's herd books.

## APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Application for membership can be made either on your own behalf or in the name of a company or partnership. For stud membership, this name will represent the owner of the stud. In the case of a company or partners, one person should be identified to act as the representative or agent. For a stud membership, this nominee enjoys voting rights.
